We, the undersigned, believe that the Lowe Enterprises proposal to develop the Pan & Fork property now under discussion in Basalt should be delayed until further review and discussion can occur in our community.

We, the undersigned, believe in and support the vision and guiding principles of the Downtown Area Advisory Committee's Final Report. The Lowe Enterprises proposal does not follow these in any recognizable way. Those guiding principles are:

- Connect the Town to the Rivers;
- Preserve significant physical and visual access to the Rivers;
