Pam,

I am writing in support of res. 34 as it supports the vision set forth by the majority of Basalt residents and captured by the 12 month Our Town Planning process.

Furthermore, I wholly support a plan which proposes reasonable residential density and integration of compatible mixed uses along the developable portion of the Pan & Fork/CDC property.

Downtown is in dire need of permanent residential occupancy which can only be achieved with significant residential density, a point that aligns well with Basalt goals for a more sustainable community. Assigning density where it is most appropriate, downtown, is the first and most important step in curbing rampant outward growth (sprawl). Simultaneously, encouraging density downtown, specifically residential, helps preserve walkable street character and feeds local retail--both essential ingredients in achieving 'charm.'

Intermittently active uses such as a passive park, or entertainment venue without adequate accompanying density, likely in excess of 10-15 units/acre, encourages a community centered around driving. The resultant sporadic ebb and flow of traffic downtown, where residents live elsewhere and only come downtown under special circumstances is not adequate to maintain a thriving downtown.
